



COMMUNITY GROUPS AT RCFM

The following guidelines are in effect for selecting community groups and non profit groups to appear at the market.

Priority will be given to groups:

- Working in New Westminister;
- Working on issues surrounding food sustainability, agricultural land preservation, farming, fitness, health, and the environment;
- Are a recognized community group.

Other groups may be considered if space is available provided the group:

- Is not engaged in direct political campaigning;
- Is working to create a better community;
- Is recognized as a community group by one of the following:
 - Are a non-profit group as registered under the Society Act of BC
 - By having a business license
 - By having at least 10 active participants

In the event that the Market Manager is unsure if a group fulfills those requirements, exceptions may be made on a case by case basis, determined by democratic vote of the Board of Directors.
